

Agreement between the Chinese Physical Society and the European Physical Society

In order to promote closer contact between physics in China and physics in Europe, the Chinese Physical Society and the European Physical Society hereby agree as follows:

1. The European Physical Society will invite the Chinese Physical Society to send a delegate to one of its major conferences each year. The Chinese Physical Society will pay the cost of travel to the country where the conference is taking place and the European Physical Society will pay the conference fee and local costs.
2. The Chinese Physical Society will invite the European Physical Society to send a delegate to the Chinese Physical Society's Fall Meeting. The European Physical Society will pay the cost of travel to China and the Chinese Physical Society will pay the conference fee and local costs.
3. The European Physical Society and the Chinese Physical Society will keep the counterpart informed of their programmes of major events and conferences.
4. The European Physical Society will send the Chinese Physical Society 12 copies of each issue of its membership magazine *Europhysics News* and one copy of each of the conference proceedings it publishes from the date of the agreement.
5. The Chinese Physical Society will send the European Physical Society one copy of each of its international conference proceedings and one copy of each issue of its membership magazine *Physics* from the date of this agreement.

This agreement shall come into immediate effect on signature by both the President of the Chinese Physical Society and the President of the European Physical Society and shall remain in force until either the Chinese Physical Society or the European Physical Society gives 12 months written notice of termination or a wish to renegotiate this agreement.
