


Agreement between the Chinese Physical Society and the Institute of Physics

In order to promote closer contact between physics in China and physics in the UK and Ireland, the Chinese Physical Society and the Institute of Physics hereby agree as follows:

1. The Institute of Physics will invite the Chinese Physical Society to send a delegate to one of its major conferences each year. The Chinese Physical Society will pay the cost of travel to the UK/Ireland and the Institute of Physics will pay the conference fee and local costs.
2. The Chinese Physical Society will invite the Institute of Physics to send a delegate to the Chinese Physical Society's Fall Meeting. The Institute of Physics will pay the cost of travel to China and the Chinese Physical Society will pay the conference fee and local costs.
3. The Institute of Physics and the Chinese Physical Society will keep one another informed of their programmes of major events and conferences, and on major issues affecting physics.
4. The Institute of Physics will offer free fellowship of the Institute of Physics to 12 eminent Chinese physicists proposed by the Chinese Physical Society, and will send the Chinese Physical Society one copy of each of the conference proceedings and major reports it publishes from the date of the agreement.
5. The Chinese Physical Society will send the Institute of Physics one copy of each of its international conference proceedings and one copy of each issue of its membership magazine *Physics* from the date of this agreement.


This agreement shall come into immediate effect on signature by both the President of the Chinese Physical Society and the President of the Institute of Physics and shall remain in force until either the Chinese Physical Society or the Institute of Physics gives 12 months written notice of termination or a wish to renegotiate this agreement.
